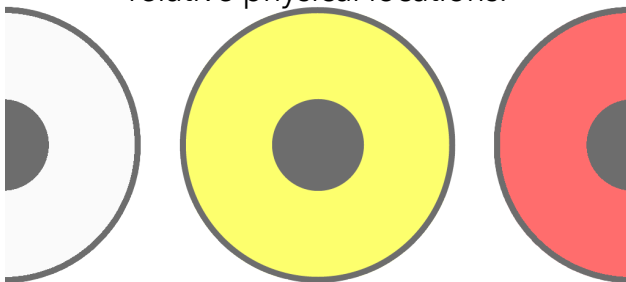


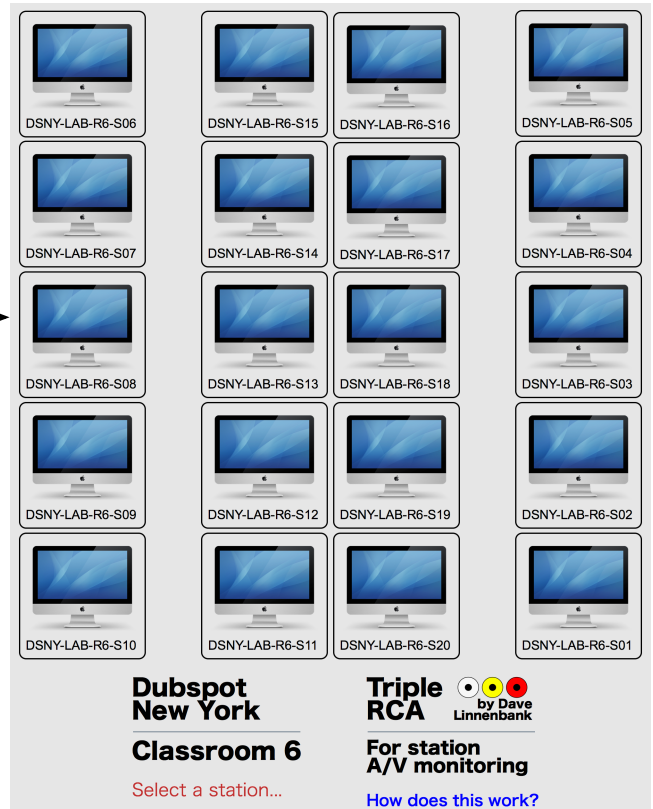
Triple RCA, a program for sharing a computer's display and audio

HOW IT WORKS: Launching *Triple RCA* presents a control panel that displays every computer in the room in their relative physical locations.



Main Interface

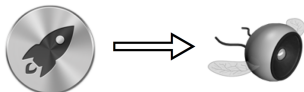


How does this work? Dialog

For station A/V monitoring

Step 1: Get your students to go into the Launchpad and open Soundfly.



Step 2: Get your students to set their application's audio output to:

Soundflower (2 ch)

(If the program they are using has no audio settings, you can skip this step.)

Step 3: Select the station you wish to monitor in the other window of this program. Tada. [Close this window.](#)

When a station is selected, Apple's screen sharing service and a third-party audio sharing device (*Soundfly*) are configured and then launched.

By clicking on a different station, any active connections are closed and the new station is connected to.

Documentation for the "student" stations is included within the program.
